Tournament Format

- 4 Player Shotgun, Best ball competition.
- All players in the group must tee off.
- The best drive is then selected and all players bring their balls to that point. One of each player's drives must be used on both the front nine and the back nine holes.
- All players hit their next shot from that point. The ball can be placed within one club length from the ball selected. Place the ball no closer to the hole and under the same conditions, e.g., a ball in the rough cannot be moved to the fairway.
- Play progresses in the same manner until the ball is holed out. Only one score is written down for the team.
- On the green, all players putt from the best point selected by placing their ball within 6 inches of the point selected, but no closer to the hole. First ball in counts. Please don't putt out the rest of the balls.
- Gentleman play from the white tees and Ladies play from the red tees.
- If your group has only three players, one player will take an extra shot on each hole. The player taking the extra shot should rotate among the 3 players of your group.

Contest Holes

- **Longest Drive:** Ball must lay in the fairway, if your drive is further than the marker, move the marker to your ball and add your name to the list, continue play.
- **Closest to the pin:** Ball must be on the green to count. Measure the distance from ball to pin – if your ball is closer than the previous players on the list, add your name to the sheet.
- In case of a tie, performance on the 18th hole will determine the winner.

On completion of play, please turn in your score card to the pro shop as they will tabulate the scores.

This shotgun format is designed for fast play and an opportunity to network with other players in the foursome. Please keep pace with the group in front of you and most importantly have a Great Time!
